



The Prescription Drug Drop Box will be available Monday through Friday from 8a.m. to 5p.m. in the lobby of the Cocoa Police Department. Medication turn-in is always anonymous. Prescription and over-the-counter solid-dosage medications such as tablets and capsules will be accepted.

The agency accepted the box from Venice Police Department who it was awarded to by the National Association of Drug Diversion Investigations (NADDI) after receiving one donated by citizens of their community. The Cocoa Police Department coordinated with Venice PD and NADDI to relocate the grant funded box to Cocoa.

Health leaders from hospitals, health departments and substance abuse prevention coalitions have been working together to combat prescription drug abuse and misuse through the Safe Rx: Campaign for Responsible Prescriptions. . *“Safe disposal of medications will help protect our community and our environment”*, said Chief Mark Klayman.
